### Book now for the 2002 conference

The conference programme is nearly complete and covers a wide range of topics of interest to every patient, whether on dialysis or transplanted, and also to carers. The opening speaker, **Professor Terry Feest** from Bristol, will discuss *Daily haemodialysis – is it for you?* **Maggie Steele**, research sister at St Helier Hospital, will talk about *A new access for peritoneal dialysis?* **Sue Falvey**, UK Transplant director of donor care and co-ordination, will give a *UK Transplant Update*.

**Dr Tony Chu**, consultant dermatologist at Hammersmith Hospital, will give advice on *Prevention and management of skin problems in renal patients. Help and benefits for carers* is the subject of a talk by social worker **Jane Atha**, of the James Cook University Hospital, in Middlesbrough, and NKF chief executive **Tim Statham** will ask the question *Your NKF – does it do what you want?*

After each speaker, an invited patient will give a personal view on the presented subject and there will be a morning and afternoon question time. On Sunday morning, there are two workshops to choose from – *Developing a KPA newsletter and website* led by **Anne Strange** and **Richard Okell**, and *Benefits*, led by **Simon Wall**.

Add to that the pleasure of staying in a top class hotel, with en suite rooms, a swimming pool and gym, and set in 11 acres of woodlands and gardens, and you will see that it is an opportunity not to be missed.
