

## **Information Update from Department of Health**

### **Swine Flu – Wednesday 20 May 3:30pm**

Two patients in England have been confirmed with swine flu today: one adult and a child from the London region – one linked to a previously confirmed case and the other linked to a recently returned traveller. This brings the current UK cases to 109.

A Department of Health spokesperson said:

“The localised cases of swine flu found in the UK have so far been mild, and our strategy of containing the spread with anti-virals appears to have been effective in reducing symptoms and preventing further spread of infection.

"But we must not be complacent – it is right to prepare for the possibility of a global pandemic. The UK's arrangements are continuing to ensure that we are well-placed to deal with this new infection."
